Notes on the completion of the Membership Form

1. You are reminded that, although your Club will take all reasonable care to minimise the risk of injuries to its students, such injuries may occur. Please remember that Aikido is a Martial Art and is therefore classified as a contact sport.
2. Students agree that they participate entirely at their own risk and to attach no responsibility whatsoever to the Association, its officers, clubs or instructors for any injury, accident, loss or damage suffered and to act with all due care to safeguard their safety and that of fellow students.
3. All data supplied on this Form will be used solely by the ADL and BAB for Aikido purposes only, strictly in accordance with the Data Protection Act (1998).
4. Please write clearly (print in CAPITALS).
5. The "Date of Birth" must be supplied if the student is under the age of 18.
6. "Emergency Contact Name" and "Emergency Contact's telephone number" fields are required for health and safety purposes. Instructors have a duty of care to their students and this information will only be used in emergencies. In cases where you are under the age of 18, such details must be those of the parent or legal guardian signing the form.
7. "Ailments" consist of injuries or illnesses, long-term and/or recent, that may affect your ability to practice; that may require specialist attention from the Instructor; or may affect the issuing of insurance.
8. Data Protection Act: You are entitled to see a copy of your records by requesting such in writing from the ADL's Data Protection Officer and by enclosing a stamped, self-addressed envelope. The address of the Data Protection Officer is available from your Instructor. The ADL Data Protection Officer will respond to your request within 25 working days.

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MEMBERSHIP FEES

Insurance

A compulsory indemnity insurance fee of £1.65 which entitles the student to three introductory classes is to be paid before a student is allowed to practise – this is covered by TVAC.

This insurance will also provide cover for the remainder of the membership year, expiring at the end of the following February.

Membership

The membership year runs from 1 March to the end of February. For students joining after the end of May, the annual subscription is prorated on the basis of the remaining quarters of the year as detailed:

June to August less 25%

September to November less 50%

December to February less 75% + following years rate.
